

Consistory Notes

April 21, 2021

The consistory meeting opened with prayer and devotions.

It was shared that we will be having ten seniors recognized in our Rock ceremony on May 16.

The elders reviewed future planning and transition steps in preparation for Pastor Wayne's retirement in the early fall and having guidelines in place during our senior pastor vacancy. Future planning will include choosing a moderator/church supervisor, surveying the congregation, developing a church profile and a search committee.

Evan Fikse made profession of faith in Jesus Christ and requested baptism. He will join church on a Sunday morning in May and be baptized!

Carson Lee Vander Molen will be baptized on June 20 and Jeremy Vander Molen will be received as a member through his profession of faith on June 20.

The deacons reported March giving as follows: General Fund - \$30,871.47; Mission - \$1,840; Sunday School - \$55.97; Building Fund - \$2,828.31. General Fund Balance - \$169,563.09; Mission Fund balance - \$10,980.75.

The following was reported from the deacons:

- Two new trees for the parsonage yard will be planted by Hackert Tree Service.
- An additional \$1,000 will be given to the youth work trip to Kentucky for projects they are working on there. This trip is scheduled for late May. We have six youth and two adult sponsors going which includes Gerald & Elaine Droppert.
- It was approved to hire Josh Rozendaal as our IT contractor and pay him for the time he works at church on his own time. This reflects the growing ministry needs and use of IT in our church.
- For information: 1st Quarterly Building Fund offering was \$3,786; Easter offering was \$6,900.00

Full Consistory business included reports:

- That the south parking lot paving project is anticipated to begin in July.
- It was approved to fund the project from the following: (\$154,000) from the estate of Wilma Rozendaal, (\$26,000) from the Building Fund as of 3/31/21 leaving \$40,000 to be raised for a project estimate of \$220,000.
- Our church van will be used by Lake View Camp for Angel Tree Camps throughout the summer.
- For information: Two information meetings will be held for the congregation (April 25 & May 2) to update the church on the future direction of the RCA due to the LGBTQ issues. Pastor Carl Boersma will lead the April 25 meeting and Pastor Wayne will lead the May 2 meeting.
- A long COVID-19 delayed dedication of our church sanctuary will take place on Sunday, June 13 with a luncheon to follow.
