STARS Afterschool

How can it be August already? The majority of people with whom I have spoken seem to have the same feeling of how fast this summer has gone.

The second week of July was busy with VBS! Thanks to the many volunteers who helped make it a success with over 160 in attendance each night for Rocky Railway—Jesus' Power Pulls Us Through.

Now, we are looking forward to the beginning of fall programing with Sunday School beginning August 29 and STARS on Wednesday. September 8!

STARS - Each week we spend 30 minutes on a Bible lesson, 10 minutes on memorizing Bible verses, and 40 minutes on skill badge work. For the Bible lessons, we cover the highlights of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation using a children's study Bible. Skill badge work includes making games, painting, and learning about God's handiwork from people in the community as they explain their careers from a police officer to an artist. In addition, children have had the chance to make edible creations.

Four family meals provide the children the opportunity to share what they have learned are scheduled for October 13, November 17, February 2, and March 9.


