August 11, 2021

The consistory opened with prayer and devotions led by Gary Van Genderen.

The elders approved the following baptisms for:

- **Colt Lee**, son of **Tyler and Kaila Harsselaar**. Also welcomed into First Reformed's membership by profession of faith in Jesus Christ:
- Kenrda Fikse will be baptized and will publically join church on Sunday, August 22.
- Corey and Shelby Van Der Wilt will publically join church on September 5.
- Cheyanne Collins will publically join church on September 5. It was shared that nomination ballots for elder and deacon for the church year of 2022 will be placed in bulletins on August 22, 29 & September 5. There will be a luncheon after the worship service on Sunday, September 26 as a farewell to Pastor Wayne and Tammy in honor of his retirement.

The deacons reported the following:

- June and July giving: General Fund \$64,275.19; Mission Fund
 \$10,575.64; Building Fund \$6,129.90. General fund balance
 \$148,481.67; Mission fund balance \$8,980.48.
- Report from the Building & Grounds South parking lot excavation and paving will start the day after Labor Day.
- Building and Grounds discussed repairing the area below the steeple where old siding has started to deteriorate.
- World Wide Communion offering is designated 1/3 Talking Bibles, 1/3 STARS After School Program, 1/3 East Jasper Christian Food Pantry.

Other business included:

- We reviewed the needs of our congregation and calling team reports.
- It was noted of preparations being made for 2021-22 education year. This includes Sunday School, STARS program, Wednesday night program and Junior and Senior High Youth program. Our

STARS and Wednesday night kickoff will be on September 8 with a carnival night.

- Our volunteer staffing list was approved.
- A report from our education committee sharing a lack of attendance of our Senior High youth for Sunday school was discussed. Changes for 2022-23 will be likely.
- Rededication Sunday with the Sully Christian Reformed Church will be on September 12 with speaker Van Harden.
- The contract between First Reformed Church and Rev. Tom VandeBerg as interim pastor was approved. Pastor Tom will begin his duties at First on October 1. He will provide pastoral services (3 Sunday sermons per month and 30 hours per week in service to the church). The contract is effective on October 1 and extends for 12 months. The contract may be renewed in increments of six months, up to a total of 24 months of service. Terms longer than 24 months will require Classis approval. The contract may be terminated by either party with 30 days notice being given. Rev. Tom VandeBerg will conclude his service upon the acceptance of a call by a new Senior Pastor. Church responsibilities will be a cash salary of \$34,434 per year and housing allowance of \$24,000, annuity of \$3,897, FICA, \$500 professional development and one week of education leave, and one week of vacation per each 3 months served accruable.
- Status on the senior pastor search committee those on the search committee are: Jerry Vander Beek, Blake Dunsbergen, Ervin Arkema, Shirley Dunsbergen, Duane Van Rees, Faye Brand, Dennis Dunsbergen, Monica Nikkel and Becky Rozendaal.
- We also continue to monitor the development of (ARC) Alliance of Reformed Churches and our administrative procedure to leave the Reformed Church. The General Synod will meet in Arizona on October 14 – 19 to vote on the future of the denomination.

A note from your pastor:

Many of our congregation have asked how our home is coming along. As you know, I will be retiring this year after

40 ½ years in the gospel ministry. Next month will be my last in active Gospel ministry serving the RCA. On September 8, at our consistory meeting I will sign papers outlining my departure from Sully 1st Reformed. I will be ending my personal ministry here on September 26 (my last sermon) and officially retiring on December 31, 2021. (The consistory has graciously allowed me to be on the payroll for insurance and pension purposes as it relates to these uncertain times in our denomination).

The moving truck comes on September 28. We have been sorting, throwing, giving away and packing too, in these past weeks.

We have built a twin home in Luverne, Minnesota. Why? Our daughter & son-in-law and grandkids live there. It is also in close proximity to our other children and their families.

Our home is basically done and ready to move into. A lawn and landscaping was not done due to the drought so that will have to be worked on next year!

We will have to wait for other odds and ends to be completed but we will have a roof over our heads before the snow flies!

Thank you for praying, asking and supporting us in this new transition in our lives. We love you and First Reformed and will miss you dearly. This is where we have called home for 12 years. We are so thankful that God brought us to serve Him together!
