We have been in a series exploring the grace of God. Today we will look at offering grace. The Bible says that God didn't just intend for you to receive it but He wants you to pass it on.

Before we can look at what forgiveness really is, we have to look at what forgiveness is not!

#### What forgiveness is not:

- 1. Forgiveness is not \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 2. It isn't \_\_\_\_\_\_ the seriousness of the offense.
- You need to understand there's a difference between being \_\_\_\_\_\_ and being \_\_\_\_\_\_.
  - Wounds are \_\_\_\_\_\_, wrongs are \_\_\_\_\_
- Whenever you minimize a wrong and say, "It's no big deal!" You \_\_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness. Reserve forgiveness for the serious things!
- 3. Forgiveness is not resuming a \_\_\_\_\_\_ without \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- Forgiveness is not the same as \_\_\_\_\_\_. These are two different issues.
- There is a big difference between forgiving a person and \_\_\_\_\_\_ a person.
- In addition to forgiveness for restoration to occur first comes forgiveness that's your part if you've been hurt.
  - But on the other person's part, it takes three things:
    - \* Repentance \_\_\_\_\_
    - \* \_\_\_\_\_\_ where and when possible
    - \* Rebuilding trust this takes \_\_\_\_\_
- In a relationship that has been harmed or damaged, the other person needs to show that \_\_\_\_\_\_ and restoration has taken place.
- While forgiveness is based on grace, trust is based on \_\_\_\_\_\_ it.
- Forgiveness is not resuming a relationship without \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 4. Real forgiveness is not forgetting what \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- It is remembering but not \_\_\_\_\_\_ the pain.
- It is remembering but seeing how God \_\_\_\_\_\_ in it anyway (our illustration of Joseph in scripture Genesis 50:ff)

We see from the life of Joseph the healing that forgiveness brings! We learn from Christ's word's the power that God gives us when we let grace live in our lives. Amen.


