Consistory Notes April 20, 2022

The consistory meeting opened with prayer and devotions. The **elders shared** the following:

- Dylan & Jodie Roozeboom's profession of faith in Jesus Christ was made. They will be publically be received as members at the May 8 worship service.
- Dylan & Jodie Roozeboom requested baptism for their daughter, Reagan Beth Roozeboom. Baptism will be May 8, 2022.
- The elders reviewed the congregational needs and church family prayer needs. Our shut-ins and nursing home residents were also lifted up in prayer.
- Prayer for Crops and Industry will be during the morning worship service on May 1, 2022.
- Graduation Sunday with the Rock Ceremony will be held during the morning worship service on May 15, 2022.

The deacons reported:

- March giving: General: \$35,326.07; Mission: \$2,113.88; Sunday School: \$4.00; Building: \$4,111.74; Kaldenberg interest: \$94.65
- Deacons did not meet in regular session as they had met on April 9 to have a work day.

Reports from committees:

- Carl Boersma, Classis Leader and Steve Landhuis, Classis representative were in attendance to ask the consistory one of three questions about our church. Each consistory member gave an answer. After discussion, Carl closed with prayer.
- Pastor Tom gave an update on the Children's Ministry Director position.
- Jerry Vander Beek gave an update on the Pastoral Search Committee.
- The consistory approved the new By-Laws of the First Reformed Church of Sully and discussion was held on the new Articles of Incorporation.
- An update was given from the Next Step Transition Team on the blue survey sheets filled out by the congregation.

- After discussion, it was moved and supported First Reformed Church of Sully to join the Alliance Of Reformed Churches (ARC) upon leaving the RCA. This was a unanimous decision by the consistory.
- The congregation will vote on leaving the RCA and a second vote on joining the Alliance of Reformed Churches will be held on May 15, 2022 at the congregational meeting after the morning worship service.
