



1. Read the Scripture out loud.



- For wisdom as the Beebouts and their ministry partners increase services and intensify evangelism efforts at Clinique Olivia and as they build a new clinic in Dogon Doutchi, to open in 2020.
- For the nursing school, which opened in the fall of 2019 and is the first Christian university in Niger.
- For qualified missionary teachers each year at the Beebout children's school, Sahel Academy.
- For security in Niger as terrorist activity threatens the country from every side, and the need for proclamation of the gospel becomes more urgent.



About the ministry

Beyond the gates of the compound stretches a busy dirt road bordered by small shops, a warehouse, and many worn down mud-brick houses. This is just one corner of Niamey, Niger's capital, where its one million residents are daily confronted with the challenges of climate, unemployment, and lack of basic necessities including food and basic health care. The compound is home to CADR, the development office of the Evangelical Church of the Republic of Niger. Clinique Olivia is part of CADR, as well as a new nursing school and a guesthouse.

The Beebouts work at CADR and at Clinique Olivia, which provides affordable healthcare to folks from all over the country who regularly battle with recurrent malaria, diarrhea, and respiratory infections. The clinic and CADR staff have created a welcoming community where health issues and other challenges, life stories, and faith in God are shared.

The Dunsbergen's have known each other since the first day they started in Kindergarten at Lynnville-Sully School. It was a beautiful 80 degree


day in October when they tied the knot at First Reformed. Their parents surprised them during the ceremony by singing "the Blessing"


