**Four facts of life from James that will help you with the problems you are going through right now.**

**1. Problems are \_\_\_\_\_.**

- Scripture doesn't say \_\_\_ but whenever. You can count on problems in your life. *“... when troubles come your way...”* James 1:2

**2. Problems are \_\_\_\_\_ – the Greek word “peripipto” means “to fall into unexpectedly”.**

- Trials are not \_\_\_\_\_ *“...come your way..”* James 1:2

**3. Problems are of many \_\_\_\_\_.**

- They come in all shapes and sizes.
- They vary in \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

**4. Problems are \_\_\_\_\_. Sufferings can accomplish value in our lives.**

- Problems \_\_\_\_\_ my faith.
  - Trials test or purify my faith. *“...He has tested me through the refining fire and I have come out as pure gold.”* Job 23:10
- Problems \_\_\_\_\_ our patience.
  - The ability to “\_\_\_\_\_ under pressure. *“...your endurance has a chance to grow.”* James 1:3
- Problems \_\_\_\_\_ my character.
  - They make me like Jesus. They help me \_\_\_\_\_ in my faith. *“To be conformed to the image of the Son of God.”* Romans 8:29

**How then do we handle our problems?**

- \_\_\_\_\_. *“Consider it pure joy.”* James 1:2b
  - We don't thank God \_\_\_\_\_ the situation but we thank Him \_\_\_\_\_ the situation. James 1:2
