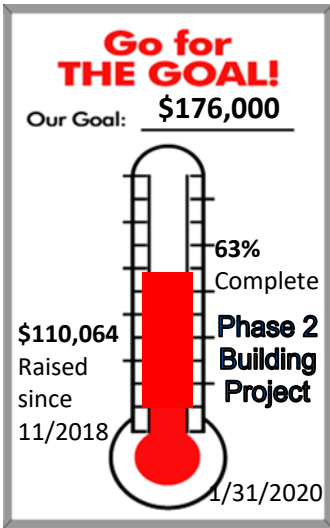
- ⇒ **Children's activity bags** are available in the back coat rooms and in the wing.
