

Consistory Notes – January 13, 2021

The Consistory meeting opened with prayer. **The elders reported the following:**

- It was noted that communion was held on January 10. "Covid" style communion has led to some very meaningful worship experiences. It was noted that shut-in communion has been temporarily discontinued until the threat of COVID eases in nursing homes, etc.
- Care team lists were approved and have been handed out with introductions and instructions to all elder and deacon and lay person care teams.
- Mason Wichhart's request to transfer into First Reformed from the Second Christian Reformed Church of Pella, IA was approved. Mason will publically be received as a member at the January 17 worship service. Welcome Mason!
- The request by Logan and Taylor Vos for the baptism of their son, Casen Jeffrey Vos was approved. Baptism will be March 14, 2021.
- The elders recommended to the full consistory the arrangements of Pastor Wayne's retirement. (see full consistory notes later in this report).
- It was noted that Pastor Wayne will be out of the office for two weeks including two Sundays of preaching due to a surgery he will have on January 19.
- It was recommended by the board of elders that due to increased attendance of Sunday services that seating arrangements be adjusted to allow additional seating in the sanctuary. Changes will be made effective for January 17 worship service.
- The consistory also discussed the letter of intent to leave the RCA and the process of informing the congregation in educational meetings. It is noted that the letter of intent will be a mute issue if the denomination's General Synod defeats the recommendation of the Vision 2020 Committee. This is the LGBTQ issue before the RCA.

The deacon board shared that December 2020 giving is as follows:

General fund: \$38,302.17; Mission: \$21,368 (includes Christ-mas Day offering of \$12,451); Sunday school: \$1455.51; Build-

- ing: \$4207.05. Ending Balance for December 2020: General Fund- \$197,296.55; Mission Fund \$17,977.96.
- It was approved to give all of our college students a \$40 gift card for Valentine's Day (we currently have 15 students).
- It was approved to let Life Serve Blood Center use the Gathering Place for a blood drive on February 16.
- It was also approved to let the Sully Lions Club meet in the Well on January 21 and February 18 for their regular meetings. (The two above events are using our church while the community center undergoes improvements.)

 The full consistory reviewed the congregational needs and shurch family prayer needs. Our shut instant pursing home.

church family prayer needs. Our shut-ins and nursing home residents were also lifted up in prayer.

Committee reports:

- Jeff Vander Molen met with the Sully City Council on the proposal to pave the church's south parking lot. The city council approved the plan with minor changes. The Building Committee will now research the cost of the project and return back to the consistory with this information.
- The Christian Education chr., Gary Van Genderen reported on events that will be held for our youth in the upcoming months which include: Youth Revival Night on January 27; Middle School Retreat in Dayton, IA April 9 11; Power Connection June 25-27 in Minnesota; Rocky Mountain High July 28 August 4 at Estes Park, Co for high school youth; Youth Work Trip led by Gerald Droppert May 29 June 6. It was approved to support these events.
- It was shared how our Youth Director, Jeff Knouse and Children's Director, Julie Van Manen were adapting their programs to fit the challenges of education in a COVID environment.
- Jeff Knouse and Pastor Duane Laman will preach for Pastor Wayne while he is recovering from his surgery.
- The consistory approved the retirement arrangements of Pastor Wayne Sneller. Pastor Wayne's last Sunday in the pulpit will be October 10, 2021. His official retirement date to be recorded with the Reformed Church Board of Benefit Services will be December 31, 2021. Concerning Pastor

- Wayne and Tammy's plan's following October 10, they will retire to Luverne, Minnesota. Pastor Wayne will have served 40 ½ in active ministry of which 12 years were served at Sully First Reformed. (A personal note: It has been quite a journey God has led us on. We began as a student pastor in Sully Reformed in the summer of 1979. What an honor it is to complete our ministry in the church where we began our adventure in serving Christ!
- By sharing these arrangements now, plans can be made for a smooth vacancy transition and for "next steps" in the pastoral leadership of First Reformed Church.
- In other business, the Executive Committee report was approved. (This report assigned all consistory members to various committees).
- The Stewardship Committee submitted projected distribution shares of the Rozendaal Mission fund for 2021. The distribution was approved as follows: Jeremy and Susan Beebout Niger, Africa \$6,400; Tom Johnson Haiti \$6,400; Chad Vanden Bosch Audio Scripture \$3,200; Brett Rockvam Center of Hope, Sioux Falls, SD \$3,200; Mission India \$3,000; Meggan & Pavlos \$3,000; LakeView Camp \$1,000; InFaith Org., Bonnie Ellis \$1,500; Kathryn De Penning \$3,000

Our last item of business was to answer the Consistorial Questions which were all answered in the affirmative. These questions are asked of the Classis and Synod concerning the health of our church!
