

Consistory Notes

June 16, 2021

The consistory opened with prayer and devotions led by Doug Huyser.

The elders reported that an Interim Ministry Contract was being reviewed for Rev. Tom VandeBerg. A future special consistory meeting will be held in July with Pastor Tom before anything becomes official. Responsibilities that would be part of his ministry here during our Senior Pastor vacancy will be reviewed.

Currently Pastor Tom is serving as Interim at Cross-roads (Reformed) in Norwalk, IA. He retired from Adventure Life (Altoona) Reformed in December of 2019.

Discussion was held concerning any action with a letter of intent to leave the denomination.

Before any action is taken, Pastor Wayne will contact the nine classis churches that have already filed this letter. Pastor Wayne will find out what action was taken, if any, by these congregations prior to filing the letter.

The congregation's needs were reviewed followed by prayer.

The deacons reported the following:

May giving: General Fund - \$34,649.49; Mission Fund - \$10,287.50; Sunday school - \$157.75; Building Fund - \$2.62 (interest). General Fund balance - \$163,133.05; Mission Fund balance - \$6,643.43

Other business items included:

- Approving up to \$350 monthly insurance for Jeff Knouse.
- Approving \$1,000 to the Vacation Bible School

- Approving \$100 to Smoke on the Water (Boyd Arthur benefit this year)
- Designating Labor Day offering will go 1/3 Mission Fund, 1/3 to Words of Hope, & 1/3 to Gideon's International
- Information: Memorial Day Offering was \$4,015.00.
- The aim is to start the pavement project on the south parking lot in late July or early August.

The full consistory began the process of submitting names to be considered for the Senior Pastor Search committee.

It was approved to grant Pastor Wayne's request that September 26, 2021 be his last Sunday. This moved up the previous stated last Sunday by two weeks. The purpose is to have all of his retirement declarations for each RCA business judicatory filed and completed before Synod meets on October 14-19, 2021.
