Pastor Duane Laman 9:30 a.m. July 11, 2021

- 1. Many of the so called, smartest people in the world believe this world just happened by chance and by accident, with no plan and no Creator designer (God). Does that seem possible to you? Why or why not?
- 2. Could the Bible be right when in Psalm 14:1 it says: "The fool says in his heart, 'There is no God."
- 3. When someone says something like: "Nobody can prove God exists!", does it immediately make you think, "Yes, but it's equally true that nobody can prove a Creator God does not exist."
- 4. Does it make more sense to believe a Creator God made everything than that it just happened on its own?
- 5. Even if this world could not have just happened on its own, do you think people could have just later become an accident and a mistake upon this earth, as Mark Twain believed?
- 6. Do you think 100 trillion atoms could accidentally line up on their own to make a living cell?
- 7. Do you think that then 724 trillion cells could accidentally line up to make you who you are?
- 8. Rather than believing we are mistakes and accidents, do you think it would make more sense to believe Psalm 139:14 that we are fearfully and wonderfully made?
- 9. The Bible teaches that God made us in His own image and breathed into us the breath of life. Why do you think God did not just destroy mankind when they sinned? Could God not easily have started over by making some different people? Why didn't He?
- 10. How do you think God called to them, "Where are you?" when God sought them in the garden?
