

Informational Update to Sully First Reformed Church congregation From the Next Step Transitional Team

Our Consistory has set up a Next Step Transitional Team, consisting of members: Craig Maasdam (chairman), Ervin Arkema, Arloa Harthoorn, Ryan Mortvedt, Gar Van Genderen, and Eloise Vos. Interim Pastor Tom VandeBerg is also participating in the team's meetings. The purpose of this team is to investigate denomination options for the future of our church here in Sully. Our church is a member of the (RCA) Reformed Church in America denomination. While the official standing and policies of our denomination have remained in line with our local church's beliefs and practices, the denomination has failed to enforce their stance on various issues, particularly with regard to issues relating to human sexuality, i.e. same sex "marriage". This has resulted in a deep division in our denomination. Many churches are leaving the Reformed Church in America denomination or making plans to do so.

The Next Step Transitional Team will evaluate potential denominations for our church to join. A recommendation will be made to the consistory. If the Consistory votes in favor of a change, a special Congregational Meeting will be held and 75% of the Congregation will be required to vote in favor of leaving the Reformed Church in America denomination and in favor of joining another denomination. If the outcome of the vote is to change denominations, the Next Step Transitional Team would then be in charge of preparing the numerous official documents to leave the denomination.

As of today, the Next Step Transitional Team has met with representatives of two different denominations, the Alliance of Reformed Churches (ARC) and the Evangelical Free Church of America. Consistory members have also been invited to come to these informational meetings. In the near future, the team plans to meet with the Sending Network (a new denomination based out of Third Reformed church of Pella) and possibly with the Presbyterian Church in America, the Evangelical Presbyterian Church, or others.

The Next Step Transitional Team is researching various organizations that fit us theologically and missionally since the Reformed church in America no longer does. So far, we have met with Representatives from the Alliance of Reformed Churches (ARC) and the Evangelical Free church of America (EFCA).

The Alliance of Reformed Churches (ARC) has these Strategic priorities: 1. Make disciples who follow Jesus. 2. Equip leaders for Kingdom work (personally, locally, regionally and globally). 3. Bring new ministries to life that share the gospel in their context.

ARC has 2 levels of organization, the national level being the "Alliance" level, and the "Network" level being groups of 30-60 churches. There are two staff members currently at the Alliance level of the organization. Each Network group will send one representative to serve on the national Board of Directors, and one representative to serve on the national Ministerial Oversight Team.

ARC wants as many decisions as possible to be made at the local church level. To join ARC, a church would apply to become a member and if accepted would become a member for five-year increments. At that point a church would evaluate whether they wish to continue, and ARC would evaluate if the church was abiding by the ARC's Organizational Convictions.

Each church in the Alliance would pay 1% of their quarterly income to the national "Alliance" level of ARC and 2% of their quarterly income to the "Network" level of ARC. The local church will keep ownership of their property with the exception of if the church closes, the property would then revert to the ARC.

ARC is not affiliated with any Seminaries at this time. As long as Pastors agree to the statement of "Organizational Convictions" then a pastor can be credentialed with ARC. There is no formal missions program established at this time and churches are encouraged to support their current missionaries.

The ARC affirms the Great Lakes Catechism on Marriage and Sexuality as a confessional appendix to the Heidelberg Catechism. Marriage is between a man and a woman. They also affirm the Apostles, Athanasian and Nicene Creeds as members of the global church.

A part of ARC's core belief is that men and women are created in God's image and are gifted by the Spirit to equip and lead God's people in ministry. The ARC respects individual churches positions and choices regarding ordained leadership. The ARC will always be infant baptizers. ARC believes in the Inerrancy of Scripture (the Bible is without error or fault in all its teaching and cannot be changed).
