Informational Update to Sully First Reformed Church congregation From the Next Step Transitional Team

Our Consistory has set up a Next Step Transitional Team, consisting of members: Craig Maasdam (chairman), Ervin Arkema, Arloa Harthoorn, Ryan Mortvedt, Gary Van Genderen, and Eloise Vos. Interim Pastor Tom VandeBerg is also participating in the team's meetings. The purpose of this team is to investigate denomination options for the future of our church here in Sully. Our church is a member of the (RCA) Reformed Church in America denomination. While the official standing and policies of our denomination have remained in line with our local church's beliefs and practices, the denomiat nation has failed to enforce their stance on various issues, particularly with regard to issues relating to human sexuality, i.e. same sex "marriage". This has resulted in a deep division in our denomination. Many churches are leaving the Reformed Church in America denomination or making plans to do so.

The Next Step Transitional Team will evaluate potential denominations for our church to join. A recommendation will be made to the consistory. If the Consistory votes in favor of a change, a special Congregational Meeting will be held and 75% of the Congregation will be required to vote in favor of leaving the Reformed Church in America denomination and in favor of joining another denomination. If the outcome of the vote is to change denominations, the Next Step Transitional Team would then be in charge of preparing the numerous official documents to leave the denomination.

As of today, the Next Step Transitional Team has met with representatives of two different denominations, the Alliance of Reformed Churches (ARC) and the Evangelical Free Church of America. Consistory members have also been invited to come to these informational meetings. In the near future, the team plans to meet with the Sending Network (a new denomination based out of Third Reformed church of Pella) and possibly with the Presbyterian Church in America, the Evangelical Presbyterian Church, or others.

The Evangelical Free Church of America (EFCA)

The EFCA believes that God created human beings male and female and that scripture grants two life-enhancing options for sexual behavior: monogamous marital relations between one man and one woman or sexual celibacy. Either is a gift from God. All homosexual behavior is specifically condemned as sin in both the Old and the New Testament.

The EFCA only ordains men as pastors and elders, although the EFCA offers a permanent Certificate of Christian Ministry credential which is available to both women and men. However churches are "autonomous" or free from ecclesiastical and hierarchical control. Some churches allow women to be Deacons.

On a national level, a theology conference is held annually. At that conference they try to address current issues and evaluate if there should be any changes made to the denomination's statement of Faith. On the local level: each church is free to decide its structure.

It's recommended but not required that each church in the organization pay 2% of their annual budget to the local district and 1% to the national level. The EFCA offers retirement and long-term disability plans to pastors. The local church has ownership of their property although if a church closes, the property will go to the district. The EFCA has the Trinity Evangelical Divinity Seminary in Deerfield, Illinois and Trinity Western University in Langley, British Columbia, Canada. The EFCA does not require any formal training to become a pastor. Pastoral candidates must write a 20 page paper on the Statement of faith.

The EFCA does not embrace specific creeds or confessions, and frequency of communion is decided on a local level. Communion is an open table to anyone who has professed Jesus as their Savior. The EFCA practices believer's baptism, but some churches do infant baptism and this is allowed.

The EFCA has a mission's organization called "Reach Global", but because churches are autonomous they are free to support any missionaries they choose.

- The grand piano in the Gathering Place and the sanctuary will be tuned in February.
- Consistory reviewed the job description for the Lead Pastor position and also reviewed a Congregation Feedback Survey.
