Dear Sully Reformed,

The elder board met to discuss the Governor's proclamation that churches may resume worship services beginning May 1.

While we appreciate our government officials acknowledging freedom of religion, we have decided to delay returning to in-person worship. We will continue to live stream our worship services and we are re-evaluating each week as to a start up date for in person worship.

As Jasper County is considered a Covid-19 hot spot and for the health and safety of everyone involved, we will be using the next weeks to carefully develop a return to worship plan. Rather than rushing and resuming in-person worship prematurely, we want to think through the fine details, and be prepared.

So for now:

- We will not resume in-person worship until at least May 24.
- We are working on a plan for what return to in-person worship will look like.
- We will re-evaluate our decision in the near future.
- We will continue to offer online worship opportunities. We thank you for your understanding. As always, we covet your prayers, as we navigate this unprecedented time.
