Updated COVID-19 Guidelines-11/29/2020

As COVID-19 cases continue to surge in our area and around the state, the surrounding Hospital & Clinics urge community members and businesses to join our efforts and do your part to flatten the curve and prevent the spread of the disease. We urge everyone to do all that they can to help manage the health and safety of our community and your family, friends, and co-workers during this pandemic. According to the CDC guidelines, the best way to prevent illness is to avoid exposure to this virus.

- We ask that anyone who has been exposed to, quarantined or tested positive for COVID-19, is not feeling well, or has a temperature higher than 100.4 within the past 24 hours, not attend services.
- Social distancing guidelines will be in effect in worship venues.
- To help with social distancing. We will have seating marked off in the main sanctuary to make adherence to these guidelines as easy as possible. The east wing chair rows are already spaced 6 ft. apart. Members of the same household may sit together and all others should sit six feet apart. We will define "household" as those family or non-family members who have been spending significant time together already. This could include, but would not be limited to single friends sitting together or with other families and extended families sitting together.
- We strongly encourage the wearing of masks 2 years old and older. Masks are available at each entrance.
