

Consistory Notes

October 21, 2020

Our meeting began with prayer and scripture led by Pastor Wayne.

It was shared that there will be a Town hall meeting at Otley Reformed on October 22 to discuss the denominational restructuring that might happen and to gather for a further understanding of the 2020 Vision Team Final Report. The purpose of this meeting is two-fold. First, to ensure our congregations are equipped to make important decisions and second to gather more information on the two groups/alliances that are considering the possibility of coming into being if the Reformed Church chooses to restructure due to the LGBTQ issues of ordination and marriage.

We currently have four elders and Pastor Wayne who are attending this meeting.

Time was spent reviewing our church family's spiritual and physical needs. We have had many marriages, deaths and sick this month.

The deacons shared:

- September giving as follows: General \$27,926.94; Mission \$6,233.50; Sunday school \$114.25; General Fund Balance \$18,624.59; Mission Fund Balance \$13,297.37.
- It was motioned to designate the Christmas offering to the Mission Fund.
- It was also decided to support Inspirations Childcare and Preschool Center by giving \$500 each quarter starting in October 2020. This will be reviewed on an annual basis.
- Also, approved recommendations for church staff (except for Pastor Wayne as he has call status) increases for 2021.
- For information: CROP Walk offering was \$300 which was donated to East Jasper Christian Food Pantry. World Wide Communion offering was \$2,085. Our 3rd Quarter Building Fund offering was \$6,561. Our annual church assessments for 2021 will be \$34,828. It was decided to continue the Quarterly Building offerings.

Committee reports:

 Building & Grounds reported two trees in front of the parsonage were removed due to ash borer disease. New trees to replace those cut down will be planted in the spring.

Old business:

• Reporting we have a full slate of elder and deacon nominees. Elder nominees: Brent De Jong, Joel Jansen, Gary Van Genderen,

Jerry Vander Beek, Loren Vos & Meldon Vos. Deacon nominees: Travis Chapman, Coltin Collins, Nick De Penning, Brandon Dunsbergen, Tim Dunsbergen & Ryan Mortvedt.

New Business:

- It was approved to place in our congregational meeting agenda study item by Teryl Ver Ploeg. A proposal to concrete the south parking lot as submitted.
- The November 8, 2020 congregational meeting agenda was approved. Our congregational meeting will be held after the November 8 morning service.

Other Information

- We will have a Reverse Offering on November 15. \$12,500 will be distributed to the congregation to bless others. \$50 will be distributed to each church family. Our purpose is to teach lessons in stewardship to our families and bless others. The follow through will include submitting stories (optional) on how we used this money to minister in the name of Christ. This is similar to what we did in 2017 and how we experienced God's blessings! More details will follow.
- Pastor Wayne will be preaching on stewardship in a COVID-19 world.
- Sanctuary Dedication of our Renovated worship facilities will be held on December 6! God is good!
