How do we purposely live the values that God has set before us?

### 3. Priorities – Matthew 22:36-40

- The commandments listed \_\_\_\_\_ – God first!

#### How do I put God first?

- **Give God priority in 5 areas:**

⇒**F** – Put God in your \_\_\_\_\_. The way you \_\_\_\_\_ your money says what's first in your life.

⇒**I** – \_\_\_\_\_. You can tell what a person's priorities are by seeing what they are \_\_\_\_\_ about. *"Talk with each other about the Lord."* (Living Bible)

⇒**R** – If you want God first in your life, you're going to have to choose your \_\_\_\_\_ carefully.

- Why? Because you \_\_\_\_\_ like the people you spend the most time with!

⇒**S** – Put God first in your \_\_\_\_\_! Make a daily \_\_\_\_\_ with God. *"Very early in the morning...Jesus got up and went to a solitary place where he prayed."* Mark 1:35

⇒**T** – Turn to God first in your \_\_\_\_\_.

- Prayer should not be your last \_\_\_\_\_; it should be your first \_\_\_\_\_! *"Call upon me in your day of trouble and I will deliver you."* Psalm 50:15

### 4. Practical Holiness – Presenting Jesus Christ.

- How do we \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves as God's people?

⇒First we are called to live a \_\_\_\_\_ for God. How? *"You must love the Lord your God with all your \_\_\_\_\_, all your \_\_\_\_\_, and all your \_\_\_\_\_."* Matthew 22:37

- Concentrate on \_\_\_\_\_ you do and \_\_\_\_\_ you do it! *"A second (commandment) is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself."* Matthew 22:39

A life that is lived for God and putting him first is a life that makes an \_\_\_\_\_ on our neighbor with \_\_\_\_\_ love!

## PREPARATION FOR COMMUNION

**MINISTER:** People of God, next Sunday we will be celebrating together, with the gracious help of God, the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper.

**CONGREGATION:** In order that we may celebrate the Lord's Supper and its significance in our lives, it is necessary that we examine our motives and attitudes as we come to this Supper.

**MINISTER:** First, let everyone consider their sins, asking yourself if you believe God's promise that all your sins are forgiven and that Christ's death and resurrection have enabled us to receive his grace. We are reminded that this gift has enabled us to demonstrate thankfulness to God and to live for him as we live in love and peace with our neighbor.

**CONGREGATION:** If we are of this attitude, God will welcome us in love and consider us worthy participants at the Table of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**MINISTER:** We also are reminded that the commands of our Lord Jesus Christ instruct those who are continuing in unrepented sin to keep themselves from the Lord's Table. This is not intended to distress those who have asked for forgiveness of their sins, but to remind the unrepentant of the nature of their sin and to direct them to forgiveness by our Savior Jesus Christ.

**ALL:** Let us celebrate God's loving kindness and anticipate joining together in one body under the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.
