



### **Consistory Notes**

#### September 8, 2021

The consistory opened with prayer and devotions led by Pastor Wayne. The elders reported the following:

- World Wide Communion will be held on October 3, 2021.
- Lucas Jones made profession of faith in Jesus Christ as his personal Savior and was received as a member of First Reformed. He will be publically received on September 19, 2021.
- The baptismal request by Garrett and Jade De Hoedt for their sons Odin Duane and Tate Lee was approved. Tentative date for their baptism will be September 26, 2021.
- Fall Classis will be held in person at Westview Church, Waukee on September 23. Classis delegates are Pastor Wayne and elders Craig Maasdam and Teryl Ver Ploeg. The deacons reported the following:
- August giving General: \$32,021; Mission: \$865; Sunday school: \$15.50; Building Fund: \$2,752.53. General Fund balance: \$135,182.69; \$613.43 (Mission Disbursements for August (\$10,828.82); Building Fund balance: \$39.900.00.
- Thanksgiving offering will be designated to the Mission Fund.
- Transition support from Phil and Olivia lekel (they transitioned to other job responsibilities) to Nicole Opgenorth in Nicaragua, (\$1,116 per vear).

#### Committee reports:

- South parking lot paving project to start the week of September 13th.
- Approved additional volunteers for educational positions (teachers, etc.)
- Reports shared from Children's Director Julie Van Manen and Youth reports from Jeff Knouse.
- Inter-Church Relations reported on Rededication Sunday on September 12 with Van Harden speaker.
- Pastoral relations shared that Interim pastor Rev. Tom VandeBerg will begin October 1, 2021. Pastor Wayne's last Sunday will be September 26, 2021. (see new business)

#### New Business:

- Pastor Wayne signed the Dissolution of a Pastoral Relationship due to retirement effective September 27, 2021. His official date of retirement will be on December 31, 2021 but all pastoral duties with First Reformed will cease on September 27, 2021. First Reformed will provide salary, insurance and pension until 12-31-2021. It is also noted he will preside at a June 4, 2022 wedding at First Reformed.
- Pastor Wayne also signed a Covenant of Separation (also called Future Relationship) between his role as a pastor providing ministerial and pastoral leadership with First Reformed and his transition to friend of First Reformed. This role acknowledges he will encourage members to look to the new pastoral staff for care and leadership.
- These agreements were also signed by consistory and Rev. Carl Boersma, Classis pastor representative. These agreements will be forwarded to Central Iowa Classis and the Board of Benefit Service in New York where upon their reception retirement services can be initiated to Rev. Wayne Sneller.
- Nomination results were reviewed. 81 ballots were submitted for elder and deacon. Nominee assignments for elder and deacon for contact were given.

Pastor Wayne thanked the consistory for their leadership over the 12 years he has served First Reformed as their Pastor. He encouraged them to serve with a personal passion of Christ as Savior so that grace may abound in the church!
